Apply for a visa and check the entry requirements for Germany. You need to book a flight or train ticket to get to Zwickau before your studies start.

While you are preparing for your studies in Germany, you can search for accommodation in or around Zwickau from where your are living.

PACK YOUR STUFF

Don't forget to bring specific medication if you need such. Make a note of important emergency contacts, addresses and phone numbers. Take plug adaptors. You require passport photos. In Germany, it is still customary to use cash. Make sure you bring cash with you for the first days.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW AS AN

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AT THE WHZ

There are some things to consider while studying and living in Germany. As an international student, you might not be familiar with topics such as health insurance and the broadcasting fee in Germany. However, these are very important. Read the information carefully to avoid problems with fines.

If your are an EU student, you have to get your home insurance confirmed by a German health insurer, register at the city hall and register for the broadcasting fee. As a non-EU student, you have to complete the same steps but also establish a blocked bank account and apply for a residence permit at the foreign office.

BLOCKED BANK ACCOUNT

If you are a non-EU student and want to study in Germany, you must have a blocked bank account- known as "Sperrkonto" in German. During the visa application process, it serves as evidence that you have adequate financial resources to live and study in Germany. You can choose a bank that offers this service. Some banks have online services where you can set up an account online.



To set up a blocked bank account, it must meet the following conditions:

- It must be set up with a specific amount of money. The money has to cover at least the first year in Germany.
- The blocked account can only be closed with the consent of the embassy or the foreigner's office.

FOREIGNERS OFFICE

If you are a non-EU citizen you need to apply for a student visa at the German Embassy Consulate or a visa application centre in your home country. After receiving the visa and entering Germany, you have to apply for a residence permit to study. This can be done at the foreigner's office (Ausländerbehörde). It is the same office where you can extend your visa through an appointment.

Please note that students from the campuses in Schneeberg, Markneukirchen and Reichenbach must visit a different foreigner's office than the students in Zwickau.

The following documents are required:

- · Complete residence permit application form
- 2 biometric passport photos
- Passport and its copies
- Proof of health insurance

- Lease and tenancy certificate
- Enrollment certificate
- Blocked bank account
- Administrative fee

HEALTH INSURANCE

If you study in Germany, you need to prove that you have appropriate health insurance for the duration of your studies. Please note that you cannot be enrolled without health insurance. Your insurance confirmation will be sent automatically from the insurance company to the University of Applied Sciences Zwickau.

If you're a student from a European country, your home health insurance must be confirmed by the German state health insurance.



The following documents are required:

- Passport
- Letter of Admission

REGISTER AT THE CITY HALL

If you live in Zwickau, you must register at the city hall. Do it within the first two weeks upon your arrival. For your registration, you have to make an online appointment at the city hall or visit during the opening hours.

Bring your ID and the proof of residence (Wohnungsgeberbescheinigung (WGB)) from your landlord to your registration appointment. Without these documents, registration isn't possible and you have to make a new appointment. Keep in mind that the failure to register your residence can lead to a fine.



ARD / ZDF DEUTSCHLANDRADIO BROADCASTING CONTRIBUTION

In Germany, apart from the rent, you have to pay a fee for radio/TV services, even if you don't own a TV set or radio.

It is irrelevant if you live in an apartment or in a shared flat, the fee has to be paid per household. You can register to pay this fee on your own, or if you share a flat, talk with your roomates about the contribution.

Do not ignore the letters referring to "Rundfunkbeitrag" (broadcasting fee). If you do not pay, a strict fine will be imposed, which will cost you much more than the regular fee. If you have any questions, contact the social counselling of the Studentenwerk Chemnitz-Zwickau (Page 22-23).



ENROLLMENT AND SCHEDULE

To get your student ID and your enrollment papers, you have to send a copy of your visa to the student services: studieren@fh-zwickau.de. Furthermore, you have to provide them with your valid German address. Make sure that you have transferred the semester fee and informed your health insurance to send the M10-Notification to the university. When everything is done, you will receive your enrollment papers per post. Remember to put a sticker with your last name on the mailbox to receive the letter.

Look up your seminar group on the first page of your enrollment papers. Scan the QR code to find your timetable on the website or look it up on the WHZ WebApp.



LEVEL UP YOUR

GERMAN LANGUAGE SKILLS



You can improve your German or English skills by joining a language course or learning in peer groups. Check out the various learning options on our website and follow the instructions to register for the courses.

GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSE

German language courses are offered throughout your studies. There are subject-specific courses and general language courses on various skill levels. There is one for everyone. You receive a certificate upon successful course completion.

LANGUAGE CORNER

The Language Corner is for all who want to practise their German language skills.. You meet up regularly in a group at the dormitory to discuss the topics of your choice. Besides meeting new friends and learning the language, you can get to know different cultures.

TANDEM PROJECT

The Tandem Project is designed to provide an independent way of learning a language. Tandem partners meet regularly on an informal basis to teach & learn each others native language and enjoy cultural activities together. Time, location and content of the meetings is up to the tandem partners. Enjoy this opportunity.

International

Office

The International Office assists and mentors international full-time and exchange students at the University of Applied Sciences Zwickau. We can support you throughout your studies and provide information if necessary. During your studies, we can support you with information about study-related things and events in Zwickau.

In addition, the International Office is responsible for international relationships with partner universities and research partners around the world. With the help of international partnerships, the students, professors and members of staff can learn, research and work from other countries around the world.

Furthermore, the International Office organizes different events, such as cultural evenings, and throws a Welcome Party to celebrate the start of your studies in Germany. You can use these events to get to know your fellow students and professors.

EVENTS

GOING ABROAD

Staying abroad needs to be well prepared to avoid problems caused by missing documents and wrong compensation.

Some of the degree programmes include a semester or internship abroad. This also needs to be planned to get financial support.

The International Office recommends visiting the informational events during the semester to get everything you need for planning your stay abroad.



In Zwickau, the WHZ is divided into the Campus City Center and the Campus Scheffelberg. At the Campus City Center, you will find the following faculties: Automotive Production and Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Physical Engineering/ Computer Sciences. At the Scheffelberg Campus, you'll find the faculties of Business and Economics, Automotive Engineering, Applied Languages & Intercultural Communication, as well as Health and Healthcare Sciences.

Other WHZ sites are located in Schneeberg at the Faculty of Applied Arts and in Reichenbach with the Institute for Textile and Leather Technology. The Institute of Musical Instrument and Construction, which also belongs to the Faculty of Applied Arts, can be found in Markneukirchen, deep in the Vogtland region.

If you have any issues with the degree program, you can contact the secretariat of your faculty or the course advisor.



Health and Healthcare Sciences

The faculty of Health and Healthcare Sciences offers an academic education in the field of social and health sciences, which is a significant part of the Life Quality Division. All programmes of the faculty are characterised by accessibility to study, the conveyance of theoretical and methodical knowledge as well as the acquisition of high social competence.

Business and Economics

With numerous courses of study, institutes and departments, the Faculty of Business and Economics instructs and conducts research in a broad range of economic fields, taking interdisciplinary approaches and offering instruction focusing on practical aspects. The faculty fosters long-standing contacts with international universities and post-graduate institutions and is an active partner of the SOKRATES and ERASMUS program.



Applied Arts Schneeberg



The Faculty of Applied Arts Schneeberg conveys theoretical scientific, artistic and design fundamentals. The broad-based programme of study offers courses, which lead to a high level of design and technical qualification. In the musical instrument-making programme with the fields of plucked and bow instruments, knowledge and skills are conveyed, which gives students the necessary expertise and skills to design and build high-quality artistic musical instruments.

Physical Engineering/Computer Siences

The Faculty of Physical Engineering/Computer Sciences offers attractive bachelor and master courses in the fields of physical technologies, microprocessor technology and computer sciences. The courses of study are accredited according to recognised guidelines and have been conceived with a practical approach.





Applied Languages and Intercultural Communications

The Faculty of Applied Languages and Intercultural Communication offers Bachelor and Master degree programmes that combine languages (Chinese, German as a Foreign Language, English, Spanish, Portuguese) with business administration and intercultural communication. Applied Media Communication German-French (B.A.) and Sign Language Interpreting (German Diplom, Master) add to the profile of the faculty as a place of renowned multilingual, multicultural and international expertise. Moreover, courses in English for specific purposes are offered to WHZ students on intermediate and advanced level.

Automotive and Mechanical Engineering

The Faculty of Automotive and Mechanical Engineering is one of the WHZ's most active research faculties. Its courses of study are closely aligned with the development and manufacturing of automobiles. Results from research and development work are integrated into modern, hands-on instruction. Additional interdisciplinary knowledge is also conveyed. As a result, the programmes of study and areas of specialisation optimally meet the requirements for subsequent careers.





Electrical Engineering

Since the founding of the engineering school on April 26, 1897, electrical engineers have been trained in Zwickau. Electrical engineering and electronics are indispensable requirements for innovation in all sectors of modern industry. With its current degree courses, the Faculty of Electrical Engineering meets the growing demand from industry and research institutions for graduates with extensive and application-oriented specialist knowledge. The faculty offers a strong cooperation between knowledge transfer and internships within and outside the university as well as a large research environment.





Automotive Engineering

The Faculty of Automotive Engineering is a centre for educating tomorrow's engineers in the automobile industry. It is a competent partner in the fields of research and development. The faculties offer a comprehensive selection of programmes relating to automobiles.



DEPARTMENT OF

STUDENT AFFAIRS



The Department of Student Affairs (DSA) supports you with the information on study-related matters. Upon your arrival, you will get your enrollment documents, your student ID and your login data from the DSA. Furthermore, the department is responsible for student counselling, admission, enrollment, re-registration and examinations. At the end of the studies, you will receive your certificate from the department.



Re-registration

The students must re-enroll every semester. To do so, you need to pay the semester fee on time. The semester fee consists of the semester ticket fee, student council and student union fees. The amount may vary, so check your semester fee in the student services portal before making the payment. Make sure you transfer the correct amount of money and include the purpose of the payment based on the information given. In case of delayed payment, you will have to pay an additional late-registration fee of 15 Euros. If you don't re-register in time, you will be exmatriculated. Please note: You can't pay the semester fee in cash. You have to make a bank transfer.

Re-registration period:

Winter Semester: 01.07. - 15.08. Summer Semester: 01.01. - 15.02.



Campus Portal - Student Services

The portal can be accessed with your login and password. You can use the portal to change personal information and postal address, check on payments to the university or download important documents, such as the enrollment certificate.

Examination Portal

You have to register for exams in advance. You can only participate in an exam when you have registered for it. In general, exam registration starts six weeks before the exam period and ends two weeks before the examination period starts. You can withdraw from scheduled exams using the same online platform. If you are ill, send an e-mail with the copy of your medical certificate (Attest) to Dezernat.Studienangelegenheiten@fh-zwickau.de.



Student ID



You will receive your student ID with your enrollment documents. Your card is only valid if it is stamped for the current semester. It has to be validated at a validator each semester. The student ID is multifunctional. You can use it for the library and as an electronic wallet for the canteen and printing. Furthermore, you can use it as a key to enter the computer pools or the lecture halls.

If you lose your student ID, contact student services (studieren@fh-zwickau.de) to get a new one. Please note, that you will have to pay 10 euros for a replacement.

Germany Semester Ticket (Deutschlandsemesterticket)

The Germany Semester Ticket is available in a digital form via the mobile website "RIDE". The ticket allows you to use the public transportation network throughout Germany. It isn't valid for all trains, trams and buses. Do your research before you get on the bus, tram or train. You will need to show your student ID as proof that you are a student. Keep in mind that ticket conditions may change during your studies.





The Career Service of the WHZ is an intermediary between the university and companies offering job opportunities. Its service includes individual consultations and workshops preparing for the professional career as well as support when searching for internships, part-time jobs and graduation thesis partners.

Various workshops and events will help you to find the perfect internship partner during your studies. You will find the upcoming events on our website.

UNIVERSITY

Every student can use the university library. You can borrow books, magazines and other media for your research by simply using your student ID. Furthermore, the university library offers quiet spaces to study and research. There are also computer workspaces available for working on it with your login data.

The headquarters of the university library is located in the center of Zwickau, near the Campus City Center. There are also libraries at the Campus Scheffelstraße, as well as in Markneukrichen and in Schneeberg.

Your student ID is your library card. This allows you to use the self-checkout and lockers, as well as pay for library fees (including inter-library loans), copying and printing of materials.

The loan period for every borrowed media is four weeks. You can extend the period for a maximum of three consecutive times. The media can be returned to any location. In addition, the main library in the Campus City Center offers a return flap, where you can return the media 24/7. You find it next to the staff entrance.

To access our email service from outside the university network, you need a secured connection via our VPN service.



The Student Union Zwickau-Chemnitz (Studentenwerk Chemnitz-Zwickau) offers a comprehensive service related to studying and supports WHZ students with financial, social and cultural services. Additionally, the Student Union offers different counselling opportunities free of charge.

For general questions, students can visit the student union during the opening hours. To address more complex issues, it is recommended to arrange an individual appointment with an advisor via email or phone beforehand.

Canteens & Cafeterias

The canteens and cafeterias at the Campus City Center and the Campus Scheffelstraße are run by the Student Union. They provide various meals from Monday to Friday. Besides breakfast and snacks, the canteens offer three to four lunch meals per day.

The student ID card serves as a pay card in the canteens and cafeterias. Before using the card, you have to load it up with money. The top-up machines are located in front of the canteens and cafeterias.



Student Accommodation



The Student Union offers student accommodation in Zwickau and Schneeberg. The advantage of living in a dormitory is that the utility costs and extra costs such as fitness studio, table tennis or reading cafés are included in the rent. Furthermore, the dormitories are equipped with laundry rooms, student clubs and bicycle storage rooms. The rooms are usually cheaper than the rooms from the housing companies.

We recommend you arrive on a week day (or make an appointment beforehand) to easily receive your room keys. Note, that the dorm's office is closed during weekends.

Psychological Counselling

The Psychological Counselling service offers private and confidential counselling meetings in case of study crises, identity and orientation problems, difficulties with concentrating, exam anxiety or work disorders, loneliness and contact problems, as well as partnership and relationship conflicts. Appointments have to be arranged via e-mail.

Legal Counselling

The Student Union offers a Legal Counselling service for their students. In case of legal questions, regarding the interaction with public authorities or other problems, the Legal Counselling service provides information and advice in terms of legal proceedings and possible legal steps.



The city on the Zwickau Mulde River is famous for its long tradition in the automotive industry, as well as the composers, Robert Schumann and Clara Wieck. Shops and restaurants in the historical city center provide an ideal place to spend your free time. With 87,000 inhabitants, Zwickau is one of the largest cities in Saxony. The city offers different events throughout the year. Besides the intercultural event Zwikkolör and the city festival, there are events like marathons and the Christmas Market. The surroundings of Zwickau also offer different opportunities for a day trip. You can use the Germany Semster Ticket to get to the different locations around Zwickau.

Leipzig

The special flair of Leipzig definitely makes a visit worthwhile. With the Leipzig Book Fair, the Wave Gothic Festival or simply a visit to the zoo, there is always something to see and do in Leipzig.

Saxon Switzerland

Spanning both sides of the Elbe River between the Czech city Dècín and Saxony's Pirna, the rocky landscape of Saxon Switzerland offers a spectacular view. Perfect for hiking trips.

Dresden

It's the capital city and political centre of Saxony and internationally recognized for its beautiful baroque architecture. The Frauenkirche, the Semperoper and the Zwinger are a few sights that you shouldn't miss.

The students of the WHZ run three student clubs on the different campuses, which you can visit daily to meet friends and get to know other students.



ROAD MAP

CAMPUS CITY CENTER

The University of Applied Sciences Zwickau has different campuses in Zwickau. The location of the lectures depends on your faculty. The Campus City Center is the main Campus of the University of Applied Sciences Zwickau. Besides the International Office, the Department of Student Affairs and Rectorate, it is also home to the Faculties of Automotive and Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Physical Engineering/Computer Sciences. If your course of study belongs to one of the above-mentioned faculties, your lectures will mainly be held in the city center.

Find your classroom:

The houses at the Campus City Center are named after different personalities of the University of Applied Sciences Zwickau. Because the names are sometimes too long, they are often used in short form. It's important to know the short forms, to find the houses and rooms you're looking for. The numbering at the Campus City Center looks like the following example.

The first three letters show the house, where the lecture takes place. It's the short form of the name. Here you will find the number of the room. Please note that some rooms are not easy to find. Keep on searching.

CAMPUS SCHEFFELSTRAßE

Campus Scheffelstraße is the second Campus in Zwickau and is located in the Eckersbach neighborhood. It's home to four different faculties: Applied Languages and Intercultural Communication, Health and Healthcare Sciences, Faculty of Business and Economics and Automotive Engineering. If your course of study belongs to one of these faculties, your lectures will mainly be held on this campus.

Find your classroom:

The numbering on Campus Scheffelberg is different from the Campus City Center. Houses are not named after personalities of the university. They are numbered. To find your room, use our example to understand the system.

S is for Campus Scheffelstraße

S 6 2 1 3

The last numbers show you the correct room in the building.

The first number following the "S" shows you the number of the house, where your lecture takes place. The second number shows you the floor in the bulding. Sometimes there are only two numbers. In that case the house has only one floor.

DEPARTURE CHECKLIST

APPLICATION FOR DE-REGISTRATION You must apply for the de-registration via the student service portal. Deactivate your student ID in the WHZ WebApp and get your remaining amount of money refunded at the cafeteria. Don't forget to return all the books to the library.	
CANCEL YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE Cancel your health insurance 4 weeks before your departure. Make sure that there is no outstanding balance.	
CANCEL YOUR REGISTRATION AT THE CITY HALL Cancel your registration at city hall when you move out. Bring along your ID. CANCEL THE LEASE CONTRACT	
You have to cancel your rental contract in advance. You will find the deadline on your rental agreement. Afterwards, return the keys to your landlord. If you live in the dorms, you have to fill out the checklist too (Laufzettel für den Auszug).	
CLOSE THE BANK ACCOUNT Cancel your bank account. To cancel your blocked bank account, you will need the release certificate from the foreign office.
