





Sächsische Schweiz (“Saxon Switzerland”)

- You can get there easily with your semester ticket

- You can reach it easily with the “Vogtlandbahn”
- Simply take the VBG RB2 to “Jocketa” and then you can walk the rest on foot

 - Rent a boat




Markkleeberger See


- Another lovely lake with long beaches to relax and many routes for hiking, biking or inline skating
- Use your Semester Ticket to travel on the S5/S5X to Markkleeberg and walk to the lake (2,5 km)
- There are many more Lakes like this in the south of Leipzig, which you can reach via Tram from Leipzig Main Station (note: this is not part of the Semester ticket, buy an extra ticket!)



Kletterwald (Climbing Park) Dresdner Heide

- Area with many different climbing parkours with different difficulty levels
- Easy to reach via train – Travel from Zwickau to “Dresden Main Station” and then use the S-Bahn to “Dresden Klotzsche”.



Görlitz

- Lovely city in the east of Saxony with a nice and historic old town
- Görlitz is a city which is “cut in half” by the German-Polish Border, so there is a Polish and a German site of the city
- Just go to Dresden Main Station and then use the TLX train to get there

- You can find a lot of different sights [here](#)




Bautzen





In Dresden:



**DEUTSCHES
HYGIENE-MUSEUM
DRESDEN**

This museum does not offer much on „hygiene“, but has regular themed exhibitions about different topics, attracting thousands of visitors per year via their interesting multimedia approach.



In this museum, you will find out everything about the history of transportation, from horse carriages through cars to planes and rockets. It is very interactive and you are sure to learn a lot during your visit :)



We highly recommend these museums

In Leipzig:



Since 2003, this location has put on display the most interesting 360° panoramas in the world. Currently they are showing an amazing view of a garden from the perspective of an ant. Don't miss this unique experience!



The Völkerschlachtdenkmal is a 91 m high monument from the 20th century, in memory of the enormous battle fought here in the 19th century between Napoleon and a coalition against him. Don't miss the amazing view from the platform on the top of the monument!

In Chemnitz:



The State Museum of Archaeology covers 300,000 years of human history in Saxony, up until the period of industrialization. Revisit the history of human development with the help of original artifacts from the past, as well as multimedia. Be sure to stop by for a visit!



The Industriemuseum Chemnitz shows the industrialisation and how that connects with the social and economic history of Saxony. It starts at the end of the 18th century and ends in the present. Visit this museum to learn about this important aspect of Saxon History!
